The Word of God says in

2Timothy 3:16—"All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteous."

1. Lump, hard knot or thickening inside the breast or underarm area
2. Swelling, warmth, redness or darkening of the breast
3. Change in the size or shape of the breast
4. Dimpling or puckering of the skin
5. Itchy, scaly rash or sore on the nipple
6. Pulling in of your nipple or other parts of the breast
7. Nipple discharge that starts suddenly
8. New pain in one spot that doesn't go away
