and had softened my heart, all I could hear was one word; he said one word "**Release**" and my tongue was released unto God by His Spirit. I say to you, God is a Wonder! He'll give you what you need when you need it! God has a purpose for every time He delivers you.

- In order for the Jews to be saved from slaughter, Esther called for a fast for all the Jews; 3 days and 3 nights (no food nor water) which prepared her to go before the king. There was a preparation of body, soul, and spirit to this strategy! (Read Esth.4-5)

Although God is not mention in the Book of Esther, all the Jews surrendered to God Almighty. From a human point of view everything was against Esther and this mission:

- the law was against her because nobody was allowed to interrupt the king;
- and the government was against her, for the decree said that she was to be slain.

We know that if God be for us, who can be against us Rom.8:31. Therefore, throughout this ordeal God protected all the Jews and delivered them from destruction.

I had a car accident in 2007 where a truck broadsided me; the man lied and said I ran the light. I know I didn't, they gave me the ticket and I had to go to court. But let me tell you, God's protection was upon me in the car accident and in the court. This was an ordeal I had to go through, where I couldn't do anything but trust God. The police report said they had witnesses

(another lie). God had given me three coaches to build my faith. It was all about trusting God with everything! The end result was I forgave the man that hit me and lied on me and God protected and delivered me (dismissed the case). It was nobody but God!

God had spoken into my spirit, now and everyday plead the blood of Jesus over my entire body or anything else as He leads me!

- The Prodigal Son had to come to himself to come out of the state he was in. (Read Lk.15).

Do you need to come out of something that is causing you ill-will? Are you confused about why this is happening? And can you believe God to be "**your**" Deliverer? Some people have to hit rock bottom, a couple of times before they will allow God to deliver them. And sometimes you have to just watch, just as God does, and let them go through. He wants to deliver, but sometimes His hands are tied because of the will of man and He will not intervene against your will. When dealing with someone else's will all you can do is plead the blood of Jesus over them for their protection; command the enemy to take his hands off of them; and pray that they desire to come to themselves to make a just decision to move forward toward God! God gives us opportunities to respond to Him through repentance, so He can forgive us. The son had to be delivered from the life he was living. He repented of his sins (against heaven and against his father). How awesome is God? True repentance not only involved his mind and emotions; it

also involved his will. The prayers of the father protected him while the son was out there; the deliverance came through the will of true repentance.

We all had to make the decision to come out of the world's way and maybe some are not completely out of it; you're struggling and there is a war going on, on the inside. God says, it time to stop struggling! He wants to bring you to your rightful place with Him. Jesus went to the cross to deliver you from sin, that by saving you, you have eternal Salvation.

Now if you have been saved and you still need deliverance from the enemy's hold, ask the Lord to forgive you for not relying on His power to break free; to forgive you for using your strategy instead of what He would tell you to do; to forgive you for not using the authority He has given you as a believer. Now forgive anyone the Holy Spirit leads you to forgive and also forgive yourself!

Now continue to plead the blood of Jesus over everything He leads you to do (mind, will emotions, thoughts...etc) that protects you as you trust in God and He builds your faith in Him!

Use the **POWER IN THE WORD** (God's Word) continuously over your circumstance. Do not stop! Watch what enters your eyes and ears!

Fast if you are led to, for God's complete control. The enemy loves to set up control in you. And sometimes they will only leave by fasting and prayer. Command the devil to take his hands off you and leave for he is trespassing on holy ground. You have authority in **your** words in being a child of God. **God's deliverance is right at the door! God Bless!**

Health Awareness Wellness For Life From The Kelsey Korner by Sis. Esther Corners

The Common Cold is an infection of the head and chest caused by a virus. It is a type of upper respiratory infection that can affect your nose, throat, and sinuses. A cold can affect the tube that connects your middle ear and throat, as well as your windpipe, voice-box, and airways.

HOW DOES IT OCCUR?

Over 200 different viruses can cause colds. The infection spreads when viruses are passed to others by sneezing, coughing, or personal contact. You may also become infected by handling objects that were touched by someone with a cold.

You are more likely to get a cold if:

1. You are emotionally or physically stressed.
2. You are tired.
3. You do not have a healthy diet.

4. You are a smoker, or exposed to secondhand smoke.
5. You are living or working in crowded conditions.

SYMPTOMS MAY INCLUDE:

- Scratchy or sore throat.
- Sneezing.
- Runny or stuffy nose.
- Cough and watery eyes.
- Ear congestion.
- Slight fever (99° to 100° F)
- Tiredness.
- Headache.
- Loss of appetite.

Colds can usually be diagnosed from your symptoms. Common colds are different from the influenza (Flu). With the **Flu**, you develop fever and muscle aches within one to two hours. The symptoms of a cold develop more slowly and are usually milder. Your healthcare provider may need to examine you to rule out other serious infections, such as, Strep Throat & Sinusitis.

TREATMENT OF THE COMMON COLD

There are no medicines that cure a cold (sorry ☹). You can treat your

symptoms with non-prescription medicines, such as aspirin, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, nose drops or sprays, cough syrup and drops, throat lozenges, and decongestants; Vitamin C, Zinc, and Echinacea. Follow the age limit on the label.

Turn away from others and use tissues when you cough or sneeze. Avoid close contact with people who have a cold.

Wash your hands often, especially after coming in contact with someone who has a cold; use hand sanitizer.

Eat a healthy diet (preferably liquids -chicken soup or broth; Powerade, Gatorade and Pedialyte help stabilize individuals who have depleted certain chemicals in their body in some way (restoring energy- read the label, every patient is different). But drink plenty of water!--Water, juice, clear broth or warm lemon water with honey helps loosen congestion and prevents dehydration. Avoid alcohol, coffee and caffeinated sodas, which make dehydration worse.). Do not smoke!


