Tom McGuinness, co-pilot of Flight 11 crashed into the North Tower of the World Trade Center. His wife Cheryl, who lived in New Hampshire had to go to her children's school to tell the news of the father's death in that crash.

Later her daughter revealed to her mom, *"I'm so glad you're not angry at God. I know God didn't cause this to happen. God is getting me through this; He is my strength."*

Likewise, one night, her son offered comfort when she was crying. He put his arms around his mom and hugged her and said, *"Mom, everything will be alright. Our life on earth is so short. Our life in heaven with dad is eternity!"*

Cheryl's chief responsibility and ministry was taking care of her kids. Months after the

terrorist attack, Cheryl was asked to speak at her home church congregation- Bethany Church in Portsmouth, N.H. In it she calls her message **"Trust God Message"**, (trusting God for every breathe you take; this was the beginning of her healing). Talking to others heals you.

She was approached by another church member to speak at a business convention. She replied I don't want to do that! But after praying for guidance, she agreed. Since then, Cheryl has shared the **"Trust God Message"** with many different churches, civic groups, and charities (sometimes reaching crowds of 3-4 thousand people).

After one year, now Cheryl delivers a new message . She found a book that Tom had written thoughts and favorite scriptures from bible study. One particular topic was on forgiveness and how to forgive. So she says, *"If I dwell on the bad things that the (hijackers) have done, it will*

make me angry, and the anger will turn into resentment, and my resentment will make me bitter. I want my heart to be healed completely, and for that to happen, I need to forgive."

Tom's note was, *"I want to be more like Jesus, because my son wants to be like me."* The husband's legacy was outstanding. She says, *"Do I want to be remembered as an angry bitter resentful person?"* Her answer was *"No!, besides, God can't use me if I'm that way. I want to be sure that I remain pure and that my purpose is in line with God's plan for my life."*

Tithing: Mrs. Fatimar Jones, Sagemont Church

Year-in and year out, 70% of Americans live from paycheck to paycheck, barely making ends meet. Over 35% of Christian marriages end in divorce, and money problems are the number one cause. "Our Father is rich in houses and land" and it's **not His will** that we should live in bondage of sin or debt.

So why does He ask us to give 10% to Him? Tithing

was created for our benefit. It is to teach us how to keep God first in our lives and how to be unselfish people. Unselfish people make better husbands, wives, friends, relatives, employees, and employers. Prospering is a lifestyle over time. God gives instructions in His word on how to handle money.

Step 1: Acknowledge that **God is owner of everything**, including our money, home,

and children. [Ps. 24:1 "The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof; the world and they that dwell therein."] God will hold each of us accountable for how we manage them.

Many people have observed that after they stopped tithing, their finances seemed to get worse. In the Book of Malachi, God promises that if you do not rob Him of your tithes, He will rebuke your

Lord I'm so glad You appreciate me and that I'm worthy


to be used by You. As I show love and it's not reciprocated, take my eyes off that, and allow me to remember what you said when they didn't receive Your Love.

devourers and protect you. Mal. 3:8-11; Deut. 8:18 "But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is He that giveth thee power to get wealth."

If you cannot live off 90% of your income, then you cannot live off 100%. If you sit down and look at your budget, you will see that you can make it, while giving at least 10%. If you are currently in financial bondage and not tithing, vow to get out of debt and start giving some pre-determined percentage of your income. Set this amount aside before paying any bills.

Some baby steps of overcoming the debt situation:

- Read your bible - God's word provides instruction on everything, including how to handle our finances




- Stop using credit cards.
- Pay off credit card balances – lowest to highest.
- Start an emergency fund.

Step 2: Do it out of Love unto God for it is holy. Lev. 27:30 "And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S: it is holy unto the LORD." 2Corth. 9:7 (NLT) "You must each make up your own mind as to how much you should give. Don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully." God will honor your faithfulness and will bless you to give more as you get out of debt.

Step 3: Establish a testimony of His ownership by Giving. There are three levels of giving: *1st level*— the tithe, 10% of earnings; *2nd level*— offerings, an amount above the tithe; and *3rd level*— sacrificial giving, giving up

things we 'want' or 'need', to provide for the needs of others.

Tithes are used to pay the operational expenses of the church (salaries, utilities, supplies) to assist those in need, and to fund ministries of the church.

As mentioned previously, the tithe is the first level of giving. Those who currently tithe should be careful not to judge non-tithers or to think that no additional giving is necessary. Jesus gives an additional warning in Matt. 23:23 (NLT) "What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! For you are careful to tithe even the tiniest income from your herb garden, but you ignore the more important aspects of the law—justice, mercy, and faith. You should tithe, yes, but do not neglect the more important things."

Mal. 3:10a "Bring the

whole tithe unto the storehouse, so that there may be meat in my house."

Jesus has redeemed us from the conditions of the law and replaced the law with grace. In addition to the tithe, the New Testament teaches us to give according to the blessing we receive and encourages sacrificial giving.

Christians tithe as an act of faith, obedience, and as a testimony of God's ownership. He is trying to get something to us, instead of from us! When we cheerfully give, whether a tithe or an offering, God will be pleased and will bless us. If you tithe, do it out of love for God, not guilt; it is holy!

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
