SOME MORE TYPES OF PRAYER

• **Prayer of Faith/Petition** - And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. ²³For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them <u>Mark 11:22-24</u>.

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: ¹⁵And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that w desired of him 1 John 5:14-15.

GOD WANTS TO ANSWER OUR PRAYERS, SO BE SPECIFIC IN YOUR PETITION, BELIEVING THAT YOU HAVE RECEIVED IT ACCORDING TO HIS WILL.

Prayer of Agreement - Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. ²⁰ for where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them Matt.18:20.

COMBINING YOUR FAITH WITH ANOTHER AND PRAYING FOR A SPECIFIC REQUEST MUST BE IN AGREEMENT IN SPIRIT, MIND, AND ACTIONS WITH THE WORD OF GOD AND THE HOLY SPIRIT'S LEADING.

 Prayer of Intercession- Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered. ²⁷And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God Rom.8:26-27.

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 1 Tim.2:1

THIS IS A BURDEN, AND INTENSE URGENCY TO PRAY FOR ANOTHER, RESPONDING TO THE PROMPTINGS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT; PRAYING UNTIL THE BURDEN LIFTS OR YOU RECEIVE A RELEASE IN YOUR SPIRIT

There are many more prayers that are in the bible that you can pray. Three essentials are important: Knowing the Will of God through the POWER IN THE WORD! And knowing there is POWER IN THE HOLY SPIRIT'S LEADING! HAVE FAITH!!!

BE TEACHABLE WITH WORD AND POWER IN PRAYER

I asked some <u>young folks</u> lately, how many of you pray; if you do, when do you pray? You probably already know what they said.

WE NEED TO KNOW HIM

Do we as adults have a teachable spirit where the Holy Spirit can teach and guide us into all truths? Even the disciple asked Jesus in Luke 11: One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples." ² He said to them, "When you pray... So if the young folks don't know that they are to pray or even how to pray, this gives them a reason to not pray, which means those that are the adults have not been doing their job to teach them, to instruct them, to oversee to their knowing who God really is —(their Father to love; to lift up, and adore every moment of their lives; to communicate with and relate to; having prayer time: not just asking for help all the time, but just loving Him; telling Him how their day was; telling Him how precious He is to them. There is so much to talk to God about and it's not all about us. It could be about someone else.

In *Deut.6* the Israelites were told to keep God's commandments... Why?- that they would continue to do them in the land He was giving them to possess. This means, you not only do this in your earthly father's house, but you take this same fear of the Lord into the next house and the next generation would take it into their house and so forth. Verse 2 said that thou mightiest fear the Lord thy God, which means to "reverence." You can't reverence what you haven't spoken of or you just haven't been taught to regard with fear.

It also said, ⁵And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. What you love, you will reverence, meaning you've been around them to love them; you've been acquainted with them; it's in your heart, your soul, and spirit. That's how God wants you to be with Him. He wants you to be acquainted enough that you will go to Him at any time, to commune in His presence. Can you feel Him now? His warmth can overpower fear!

HIS WORD IS IMPORTANT

⁶And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: Once you get the Word of God in you, you can tell and teach others. There are no short cuts because what you don't have, you can't teach and what you don't teach, others can't receive. ⁷And thou

shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. This is so true. It was so different when children were small. When they grow older, you're still teaching, but now you've got to wait on the leading of the Holy Spirit as you teach and for them to really hear and receive what you teach. And you'll know those times.

Jesus is the teacher along with the Holy Spirit. His Word teaches us. The Holy Spirit guides us. Your heart receives. In order to receive, let your heart be empty and humbled in His presence; let your time now be about Him; let your feelings turn to His Word so that a stronger faith will grow because of His presence. He, the Holy Spirit comes alive and manifests within us the power to speak to Him because God's Spirit is guiding us into all truths of Jesus Christ; of what we have read about Him.

PRAYER CONNECTS US TO GOD AND WE SET THE POWER OF GOD INTO MOTION. BY USING THE WORD OF GOD, IT INCREASES OUR FAITH AND WE ARE THE ONES THAT BENEFIT FROM THE PRAYER ALONG WITH OTHERS.


ALLOW GOD IN YOUR WORLD

What are you allowing in your household, in your body, in your finances, in your mind? Satan may be in control at times of this world system but He is not in control of the God system. Repent sincerely and ask Him in. Paul prayed a two-fold prayer in Ephesians 3. This second part says: *Eph.3:19*— And to know the love of Christ; which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God. When we allow God in our world, we are allowing His love to transcend; to go beyond our understanding, so we can be filled with all the fullness of God. Without our agreement about His love, we can't be filled. He went to the cross because of love and if we can't accept that love, and acknowledge that love He bestows, God will not be able to fill you with His fullness. The fullness of God is all of His presence and power operating in us. We need to be full of God not ourselves. Sometimes we forget His perfect and awesome love in our lives; we forget how much He loves us; how much He has forgiven us.

²⁰He is able to do exceeding, abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us. This power only works with your faith! What is that power working in us? First, there is no power without

- 1. Those <u>Close</u> to you would be family and friends.

Instead of always praying for yourself, now, you have an order of praying for someone else that you have not even considered praying for. This opportunity can now stretch your faith for someone else.

Began to first pray for their Salvation; then for their growth in the Word of God; that ears be sensitive to God's leading; Plead the blood of Jesus over their lives for protection, that they walk in newness of life, that they have the necessary strength to do what God needs them to do. May they have health and wholeness in their bodies; God's blessings of favor be opened to them and their family etc.

agreement and unity and there is no power without the unction of the Holy Spirit. What power got Jesus out of the grave? What power quickened Him from the dead? Now, does this same power reside in you and is this same power dormant or is it alive in you? Are you allowing the Holy Spirit to be welcomed and energized in you? And lastly, are you relying on His power or are you relying on your own power? If it's His power then He's working in you; He's coming alive and manifesting His presence and power within you— The Power Of The Holy Spirit activating the Word of God. Do you think His power has ever failed you when you prayed? I don't think so! Right now I'm trying to get you to see that there is power working within you to pray and see what God will do. Don't let prayer be your last resort to receive the answer you need. His power releases that answer!

HIS ANWERS ARE AVAILABLE

Sometimes we think we know God, and why God did this or that. Let me tell you, we can never figure God out. He only reveals things in part and those things are the things we can only handle at that particular time. Then at other times He will reveal the rest, when He knows we are ready for it. Sometimes God answers with the manifestation and sometimes He answers with the answer still on hold. Any way it goes, I believe He answers every prayer. He does not answer in the same way He answered others or even in the same manner

in your other prayers prayed. Yeah, God is God all by Himself and there is no way to figure Him out. It's all about just trusting Him to do what is best for you. Just make sure you are in right fellowship with God. Know that He is a holy, just, and righteous God.

- *Abraham*: God agreed to spare Sodom and Gomorrah if He could find 10 righteous people in those cities (Gen. 18:22-32).
- Moses: God miraculously answered many of Moses' prayers including the parting the Red Sea (Exodus 14:13-22).
- *Elijah*: God miraculously answered Elijah's prayer on Mt. Carmel when he rained fire from heaven in the showdown between God and the false gods of Baal (1 Kings 18:20-40 especially 37-38).
- Daniel: Daniel's whole career was spent in prayer to God. His prayers were miraculously answered. Daniel prayed to be shown the king's undisclosed dream and God answered him (Daniel 2:17-18).
- The church prayed for Peter: The early church in Jerusalem prayed for Peter after his arrest by Herod and God miraculously answered their prayer by sending an angel to free Peter from prison (Acts 12:5-10).

Jesus has always prayed to His Father and has always been led by the Holy Spirit. His example shows us that there is a need to pray. We as the church are developed with POWER IN THE WORD and His Holy Spirit to pray to change things in our households, in our bodies, in our finances, and in our minds when we are Teachable with Word and Power in Prayer. OSTEOPOROSIS

Osteoporosis is a Bone Disease which make bones thin, weak, and brittle. Over time, this can cause the bone to break. These bone breaks happen most often in the spine, hips, and wrists.

Osteoporosis is known as a Silent Disease. Many people don't know that they even have osteoporosis until they break a bone.

SYMPTOMS OF OSTEOPOSOSIS

- HEIGHT LOSS
- Posture change
- SEVERE BACK PAIN

PREVENT BONE LOSS

- <u>Do</u> TAKE MEDICINE AS PRESCRIBED
- EAT A BALANCED DIET
- KEEP ACTIVE
- DON'T DRINK ALCOHOL
- DON'T SKIP MEALS
- Don't smoke
- GET ENOUGH CALCIUM & VITAMIN D

Your body can't make Calcium. If you do not get enough calcium, or if your body does not absorb enough calcium from your diet or supplements, bone production and bone tissues may suffer. To absorb Calcium efficiently, an adequate

amount of Vitamin D must be present.

Calcium also has benefits in other body systems by reducing blood pressure and cholesterol levels. Calcium and vitamin D supplements have been shown to help prevent tooth loss in older adults.

FOOD SOURCE FOR CALCIUM

- Diary Products: low fat or non-fat milk, cheese, yogurt, and ice cream.
- Dark leafy green vegetables: spinach, collard greens, and broccoli.
- Almonds
- Fish: sardines,
- Foods with added Calcium including orange juice, cereal, and products that have soy and tofu.

GOOD SOURCES OF VITAMIN D

Vitamin D is a fat-soluble vitamin that helps the body absorb Calcium. Vitamin D decreases bone loss and lowers the risk of fracture, especially in older men and women.

- Milk with Vitamin D
- Fish and oysters, salmon, tuna, and mackerel.
- Cereal with Vitamin D
- Sunlight
- Light-skinned: 10 to 10 minutes
- Dark-skinned: 20 minutes.

• Elderly people need 30 minutes a day of direct sunlight in order to produce adequate vitamin D.

General recommendations —

Premenopausal women and men should consume at least 1000 mg while postmenopausal women should consume 1200 mg (total diet plus supplement). You should not consume more than 2000 mg of calcium per day due to the risk of side effects.

Medications — All medications should be discussed with a healthcare provider to ensure that possible interactions with calcium are identified. Certain medications change the amount of calcium that is absorbed and/or excreted. As an example, loop diuretics (eg, furosemide, Lasix®) increase the amount of calcium excreted in the urine.

MAINTAINING AND LIVING WITH OSTEOPOSIS

- Exercise is important.
- Do weight bearing exercises
- Walking, dancing, low impact aerobics and swimming are other options.

Try to do at least 30 minutes of physical activity every day. Bone thinning occurs as part of the natural process of aging. Talk with your doctor!

PREVENTING FALLS

- Use brighter lights in your home.
- Remove small rugs and keep floors clean and clear.
- Don't use step stools
- Use non-slip mats in bathroom and shower.
