It has been a long time coming, and God is faithful! I had asked for donations to send bibles to Kenya to Pastor Isaac. In God's leading I had to change to another pastor in Kenya. Gospel Harvest Ministries in Nairobi, Kenya, under the leadership of Bishop Lawrence Owins.

By the time you receive this Newsletter, they should have received **240 bibles**.

On March 28, 2014, five boxes, a set of 48 ESV whole paperback bibles in each box were ordered were purchased to go to Kenya.

Now, another **2 cases of ESV Study Bibles** (12 in each box) and **2 cases of NIV Giant Print Bibles** (10 in each box) were ordered **April 14, 2014** and were to go to North West Region, Cameroon. These Study Bibles were to go to **Me4Real Ministry**

where Minister Delphine Fanfon instructs students ages 15-22yrs old. The Giant Print Bibles will go to her dad's ministry of **Retired Pastors**.

They are all located in North West Region of Cameroon. Our niece Alexis got me in contact with those she had known when she went to Africa. I was really glad about that.

I had all the bibles needed to be sent but I could not send them because I didn't have enough funds to send them at the International cost. I couldn't get them to the ministries. I did not count the cost to send them to Kenya or Cameroon!

Many of you had answered the call by giving funds. From the bottom of my heart I thank you for giving because you saw the need as I did. You know who you are! I also thank my church, First Missionary Baptist Church for stepping up to the plate, but I still didn't have enough money to cover the cost of mailing them Internationally. They

were just sitting and occupying space.

You know God had already set this thing up. All I had to do was not give up. I'm talking to someone who can't seem to go the extra mile; or think everything is too hard; or just don't trust God enough. **God is Able!**

He will never let you down! I was staring at about \$1300 to mail the parcels through the Postal Service.

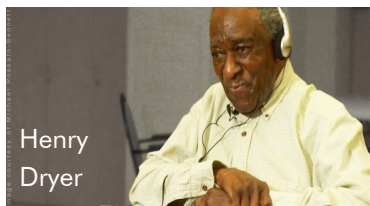

Memory that brings personalized iPods to nursing home residents and others with dementia.

Music has an unmatched power to bring back our pasts. But what if our memories have been lost to Alzheimer's or some other condition? Can music still work its magic?

A new film, *Alive Inside*, says yes. The film, opening Friday in New York, features the work of Dan Cohen, a New York social worker who started taking personalized iPods to people with dementia in nursing homes several years ago. Cohen's non-profit Music & Memory got a huge boost in 2012 when an early clip from the film, featuring a gentleman named Henry, became an online sensation. It has been viewed more than 10

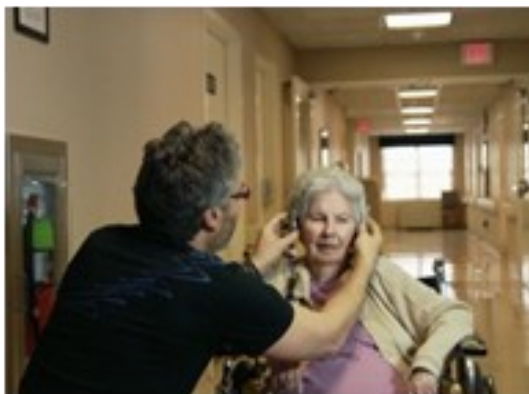

Henry, then 94, is shown slumped and unresponsive in a wheelchair – until a nursing home worker places a set of headphones over his ears. Henry comes alive. He

scats along with Cab Calloway and sings a soulful I'll Be Home for Christmas. The music "gives me the feeling of love, romance," he says.

Henry has since passed away, but that clip is one big reason that the Music & Memory program is in 640 nursing homes and assisted-living facilities, Cohen says. He says he won't be satisfied until personalized iPods – loaded with music especially chosen for each participant – are in all 16,000 U.S. nursing homes,



1.6 million residents.

In segment after segment, people with Alzheimer's and other conditions don the headphones, hear the music of their youths and light up. A World War II veteran named John dances in his chair as the Andrews Sisters sing Oh Johnny, Oh Johnny, Oh! Another man holds his wife's hands and sings a duet of Can't Take My Eyes Off of You. An agitated

woman becomes serene as she dances to strains of Schubert.

The first big study of Music & Memory is just getting underway in Wisconsin, as part of a state-funded rollout in 200 nursing homes. Researchers will look at whether the approach improves social engagement and reduces agitation, anxiety and depression, say University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee researchers Jung Kwak and Michael

Brondino. The study won't focus on memory but will look at overall effects on dementia, Brondino says. One thing they know, he says, is that staffs and patients "absolutely love this program."

Caregivers need to know that not everyone will respond and that some people can even respond negatively. A song that stirs up sadness or anger might do more harm than good, she says. Cohen says, "This is not a cure for Alzheimer's, and this does

not work for everybody." But, he says, *it is something just about anyone can try – something that might open up a whole lost world.* Cohen's tips for setting up an individualized music program and for donating used iPods to the program are
