A MASS OF WIND DESTROYED MY NERVE

TESTIMONY by Sis. Thelma R. Pramus - First Missionary Baptist Church - Houston, Texas

When I was pregnant with my first child, I had a lot of complications with my pregnancy. The year was 1972 and I was 6months pregnant when I noticed that on the left side of my face I didn't have any feelings or taste. This was unusual! However, for the safety of my child the doctor couldn't do anything until she was born.

So to fast-forward this, PaShona was born. We left the hospital and went home and the next day I was admitted again into the hospital, where I met with a specialist. My sister, Betty was able to take care of my baby while I was in the hospital. The doctor began testing by putting 50 needles in the left side of my face and one in my left eye, and came to the conclusion that my nerve on the left side was dead. He informed me to have surgery to remove that dead nerve in my face, and it had to be done immediately. He diagnosed me with having "Bell's Palsy." This is the inability to move the muscles on one side of the face, so that the expression of the face is distorted. It results from injury to the facial nerve and is usually temporary. Approximately 40,000 Americans develop Bell's Palsy each year and that is 1 of every 5,000 people. He also informed me that I wasn't going to be able to use the left side of my face anymore and I would have to continue chewing food on the right side of my mouth. There would be no taste or muscle movement on the left. He says this is from a mass of wind coming from the window I was sleeping under at night. The devil is a liar and I began to cry out to God. At this time I didn't know the Lord, but I knew enough to cry out to Him. I didn't know that this would be a testimony to help someone else.

But, God; can I say that again, But God sends another doctor to tell me that if I wanted to use that left side of my face I would have to stimulate it with a large battery for 2yrs. A large battery was hooked to a stimulator in which I received from the doctor. I had to put two patches on my face that was hooked to the stimulator and battery which would send electric shocks to my face. It would pull the left side back to the left of my face. I had to do this to my face, 3 times a day for 2yrs. After the two years was up and seeing the doctor again, he said your face looks normal and I didn't have to go back or do the shock treatments again. Now I can move my left side when I chew food and I can even taste it. I now have about 30% of even tasting my food, but that's better than having 0. Praise the Lord!

However, in 2011, when you don't have all the information, the Bells Palsy returned again to the left side of my face. In going back to the doctor, he informed me that I could not under any circumstances be under or have any wind pressure to my face. I didn't know that! I have to stay away from ceiling fans or even riding in a car with the windows down because of the pressure it gives to my ear. It would make my left side go to the right. The doctor said that it wasn't as bad as the first go-round and told me that my face would return back to normal in a few days. I have to wear scarves to cover my face from the pressure of the wind. This is a little education and knowledge that I wanted people to receive. Those that have had a diagnoses of Bell's Palsy or Facial Paralysis do not have to worry. Sometimes, it's just all apart of life and you will give a testimony of the goodness of God. It could have been something else that could take you home with Him.

So, whatever comes your way, go to the cross of Jesus and lay it at His feet. God is truly a good God and He uses doctors for His good. Praise God because He still loved me no matter what; even when I didn't even know Him like I do now I realized He cared for me and He allowed me to live to testify about His goodness! There is nothing that God wouldn't do for those who call upon His Name! Thank you my Heavenly Father, Son, and Holy Spirit for what you have done in my life! There are many more testimonies that He has given me to write about and I hope they will be a blessing to those who read them. Hallelujah!



Meningitis is fection of the mem-

branes and fluid that surround your brain and spinal cord. It can be caused by bacteria or viruses. With early diagnosis and prompt treatment, most people recover from meningitis.

Bacterial Meningitis is usually much more serious. It can lead to brain damage, hearing loss, or learning disabilities. Some forms of bacterial meningitis are contagious. The bacteria is spread through coughing, sneezing, kissing, or sharing items such as eating utensils or toothbrushes with an infected person.

Viral Meningitis can be caused by common intestinal viruses and viruses associated with mumps, or herpes infection. People can get viral meningitis from drinking polluted water. It is usually mild and often clears up within one to two weeks.

SYMPTOMS

Early symptoms can sometimes be mistaken for the Flu.

- Fever severe headache
- Stiff neck drowsiness or confusion • nausea and vomiting
- sensitivity to light

See your doctor for above symptoms. Your doctor can diagnose Meningitis by doing a spinal tap, in which he or she inserts a needle into your lower back to remove spinal fluid. The fluid can then be tested for bacteria or viruses.

TREAMENT

Viral Meningitis requires bed rest, fluids, and over the counter medication to reliever fever and headache.

Bacterial Meninaitis requires antibiotics and should be treated immediately to prevent serious complications.

PREVENTION

You can reduce your risk of getting Meningitis by washing your hands often, to prevent the spread of viruses or bacteria. Boost your immune system by eating well, exercising, and getting plenty of rest.

There are a number of vaccines available to protect against the different types of Meningitis. Talk to your doctor about the vaccinations. College students who live in dormitories are recommended to be vaccinated and also people traveling to countries where Meningitis is common.
