God comes from the only begotten Son. It comes from His death, burial, and resurrection. And it comes bringing salvation to all men. After salvation we still don't do all we're supposed to do. That's why Grace is still teaching us; is still appearing to us. Knowing this, **v12** says, "*Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world.*" How do we deny anything? We can't unless the Spirit of God lives within us; the umpire of our soul. We are to reject ungodliness and worldly desires and live self-controlled, upright and godly lives.

•**Soberly** means think serious, not as a drunk man would, but being balanced and having self-control.

•**Righteously** means justly, upright in relationships, morally.

•**godly** pertains to your relationship with God in that your life is centered on Him

There are two systems:

•**worldly**, promoted by Satan. It is in opposition to

God, to the Word of God, to God's Grace, and the purposes of the Savior.

•**godly**, promoted by God. It is His right way of doing things.

**Rom.12:2** says, *Be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind. 3rd verse says, "...Think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith."*

The world's system has flaws, but God's system is flawless. This is what God's Grace teaches us, that it's not done in our power, but in the power of the One who came to bring salvation to all men through faith.

**Eph. 2:8** *'For by grace ye are saved through faith; and not of yourselves: it is the gift of God.'*

**Teach**, we need His grace for Salvation. We are to avoid temptations and live disciplined lives.

Now, **V13** says, "*Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ;*"

In this life we are to have hope, but there is more

to come for real believers. The blessed hope refers to the Rapture of the Church and the glorious appearing will be of our Savior Jesus Christ's Second Coming.

**Matt. 24:30** says, "*And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.*"

What a glorious occasion! This is not our home and if we're influencing or saying anything to others, they will be going to heaven with us. Continue to allow the blessed hope to be your reason to influence others.

**v14.** *Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.*

•**Exhort** meaning Encour-  
age others.

•**Rebuke** meaning Bring  
light to sin—His light of the Word.

His Word does it all by itself. It does not come back void, but accomplishes what He sends it to accomplish.

Do it with authority, like you know what, you're talking about, because of "Who" resides in you. And you can speak whether

you're a woman, man, or child because it's the Word that's accomplishing, not in your might but in God's power.

**Teach** what God expects of Believers: there is a future life God wants us to be a part of. So right now, deny ungodliness and worldly lusts for we are a peculiar people because of the work of Christ. Don't waste time by promoting the enemy of your mind. Live sober, righteous, and godly lives because you have a blessed hope in His glorious appearing. Hallelujah!
